



## SIJIL PELAJARAN MALAYSIA (SPM)

Here at Abedeen Academy, Private and International Schools, we offer the national syllabus to the students. We prepare them for the major examinations in Malaysia such as UPSR, PT3 and SPM.

SPM, Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia in full or the Malaysian Certificate of Education, is a national examination taken by all students from the Malaysian public secondary schools in their final year. It is set and assessed by the Malaysia Examinations Syndicate (Lembaga Peperiksaan Malaysia).

Equivalent to the British GCSE, Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia acts as the

license for Malaysian students to further their studies into pre-university levels. Typically, SPM in Malaysia is sat by students of the age 17, also known as Form 5, in Malaysian public secondary school.

This public examination normally lasts for a month, from November to December every year and is carried out altogether at the same time across all public secondary schools across the entire nation.

Students are required to take a minimum of 7 subjects for Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia but some streams would request students to take up additional

subjects; generally 9 subjects in total. Subjects from different streams are allowed to be taken by students, with 12 subjects as the maximum. If students wish to take more than 12 subjects in SPM, they need to pay for the extra subjects and the number of subjects cannot exceed 21.


The programmes are progressive, giving the students a clearly defined path to success from 5 to 19 years. The four stages lead seamlessly from primary to secondary and pre-university


### Library




### Futsal Pitch

## HUANYU SHUIPING KAOSHI (CHINESE PROFICIENCY TEST)

### INTRODUCTION

As part of its Passport to the World Programme, Abedeen Academy introduces Huanyu Shuiping Kaoshi (HSK) or Chinese Proficiency Test for its Mandarin curriculum. HSK is the standardized test of Standard Chinese (a type of Mandarin Chinese) language proficiency of China for non-native speakers such as foreign students and overseas Chinese. It assesses non-native Chinese speakers' abilities in using the Chinese language in their daily, academic and professional

lives. HSK basically has 6 Levels (from Level I to VI). If there is any student who intend to study in the People's Republic of China, achieving Level IV and above will grant them an advantage when applying for better universities and scholarships. In Abedeen International School, HSK is already embedded in its curriculum and is a compulsory subject for each student to learn.

### EXAMINATION PRINCIPLES

The new HSK follows the principle of "test-teaching

correlation", bases the design of the test on the current trends in international Chinese language training, and is closely related to textbooks. The purpose of the test is to "promote training through testing" and "promote learning through testing". The new HSK emphasizes the objectivity and accuracy of the evaluation and stresses the learners' actual Chinese language abilities. The new HSK sets clear test objectives to allow the test takers to be able to improve their Chinese language abilities in a systematic and efficient way.

HSK Level	Vocabulary	Description
I	150	Students who are able to pass the HSK (Level I) can understand and use very simple Chinese words and phrases, meet basic needs for communication and possess the ability to further their Chinese language studies.
II	300	Students who are able to pass the HSK (Level II) have an excellent grasp of basic Chinese and can communicate in simple and routine tasks requiring a simple and direct exchange of information on familiar and routine matters.
III	600	Students who are able to pass the HSK (Level III) can communicate in Chinese at a basic level in their daily, academic and professional lives. They can manage most communication in Chinese when traveling in China.
IV	1,200	Students who are able to pass the HSK (Level IV) can converse in Chinese on a wide range of topics and are able to communicate fluently with native Chinese speakers.
V	2,500	Students who are able to pass the HSK (Level V) can read Chinese newspapers and magazines, enjoy Chinese films and plays, and give a full-length speech in Chinese.
VI	5,000+	Students who are able to pass the HSK (Level VI) can easily comprehend written and spoken information in Chinese and can effectively express themselves in Chinese, both orally and on paper.


